Christmas Card from Fr. James Magan S.J., in France, to Father Provincial in Dublin (3 December 1917) - 'P.C. A line to wish you a happy feast and a very happy Xmas. I was very sorry to hear of the death of Fr. Hogan. We had frost last night otherwise the weather is excellent. I was glad to hear you went to Tullabeg for St. Stanislaus. What do you think of the Div. Card? I am looking forward to a very happy Christmas and hope to have all my men at mass on the feast. There is no news here worth writing. I am doing Senior R.C. of Div. not Senior (non C of E) like all superiority it throws other difficulties on you and you can only do your best. With best wishes. J.W Magan S.J., C.F. '
